DRESS REHEARSAL

Dress rehearsal for all students participating is **THURSDAY, JUNE 5th, and FRIDAY, JUNE 6th at the PERKINSON CENTER FOR THE ARTS AND EDUCATION.**

Dress rehearsal is **mandatory** for all students participating in the recital. If you have extenuating circumstances that prevent you from attending the dress rehearsal, contact the office and we will do our best to accommodate you; however, this is only in situations that you absolutely cannot avoid.

A schedule for dress rehearsal can be found on the following pages. The schedule will give specific rehearsal times for each class and all dancers are expected to be at dress rehearsal at least **30 minutes prior** to their first call time. We normally run ahead of schedule and we can only wait so long in order to keep running on schedule.

Students will need to bring all costumes, tights, accessories, and shoes to dress rehearsal. Belongings can be left in the theater overnight.

Students do not need to wear full stage make-up for dress rehearsal, but may wish to wear a little for practice. If you plan on taking pictures, we suggest wearing make-up or your dancer will be washed out by the stage lights. In addition, at dress rehearsal all students **must** wear the specified hairstyle (with hair accessory if applicable) for each dance; this is a good time to practice styling the hair correctly and it looks much nicer to have the hair neat and uniform.

You may take pictures and video at dress rehearsal, but absolutely **NO PICTURES OR VIDEO CAN BE TAKEN DURING THE ACTUAL SHOW(S)**. Shutter Storm will be recording for all shows. We will also have a photo backdrop to allow pictures to be taken when classes/dancers come offstage (at dress rehearsal & the shows) and NEW this year, we will offer individual pictures with Katie Kraft (see "Pictures" for more info).

Dressing Room Assignments

Parents or guardians should check-in at the front lobby and bring the students to their assigned dressing rooms (check-in person will direct you), where they will be checked in and placed under the supervision of their parent rep. Parents are not allowed in the dressing rooms after the children have been checked in for their number unless your child has to be changed for their next dance and you have approval from the parent reps. **Dads are not allowed in the girls' dressing rooms at any time!** After the finale, parents should pick their child up at the check-in/out table. This process takes a few minutes, but the safety of your children is our number one priority, so please be patient.

The **QUICK-CHANGE** room may be utilized by anyone with **2 or less dances** between numbers. If there are 3 or more dances between numbers, we do not consider that a quick change (it equates to about 10 minutes for 3 dances). For children who feel uncomfortable changing in an open space (all windows and doors will be covered), we recommend getting a skin-tone colored leotard that they can wear under their costumes. RECITAL DAY INFORMATION/ETIQUETTE

Student Pick-up/Drop Off

Parents or guardians should check-in at the front lobby and bring the students to their assigned dressing rooms (check-in person will direct you), where they will be checked in and placed under the supervision of their parent rep. Parents are not allowed in the dressing rooms after the children have been checked in for their number unless your child has to be changed for their next dance and you have approval from the parent reps. **Dads are not allowed in the girls' dressing rooms at any time!** After the finale, parents should pick their child up at the check-in/out table. This process takes a few minutes, but the safety of your children is our number one priority, so please be patient.

Parking

Convenient on-site parking is available for free behind the Perkinson Center and at the Chester Library. There is also limited street parking available. Please be mindful of any signs indicating time limits or handicap accessibility.

Students in Audience

Due to the size constraints of The Perkinson Center, CDC students are not allowed to watch the show from the audience (unless they have a sibling in another show). Your dancer can watch the live stream from the dressing room.

Backstage Etiquette

When backstage, please be sure to remember that there are others performing on stage. With that being said, remember there is **NO TALKING!** Your voice travels with ease when backstage. Also, be sure to enter in and out of the backstage area in between dances. **Do not open** the doors during a blackout. Again, the light will travel right through to the audience. Students will be escorted in and out of the backstage area by a staff member or parent volunteer. Also, when you are backstage, be sure to stay away from the wings and do not block the entrances to the stage as there are dancers who will be entering and exiting from the stage before you.

Dressing Room Etiquette

Dressing rooms will be assigned and labeled. Please make sure that you are in the correct dressing room! When in the dressing rooms, please remember to talk quietly. **There are to be no men in the girls' dressing rooms at any time** (boys will have a separate dressing room)! Also, students are to pick up any trash and be sure you leave with everything you came in with.

Finale Bow

After the show, every student is invited to bow with their class. **We would LOVE to have all dancers onstage for our final bow!** Parents can pick their child at the check-in/check-out table after the bow.

COSTUME/HAIR REQUIREMENTS

Listed below are the specific requirements for each class. Please make sure you have all needed items and consult the appropriate faculty member with further questions. Any class that lists tights for a requirement were ordered with your costume and are not an additional requirement (if you did not receive a pair, please contact the office). If you run or lose your tights, we do have limited sizes available for purchase at the check-in table. In addition, please **DO NOT WEAR UNDERWEAR UNDER YOUR COSTUME!**

BALLET-GENERAL

- ❖ Tights were ordered for all ballet classes and were included in with your costume
- ❖ **All straps on ballet shoes MUST BE SEWN and laces MUST be tucked into shoe**
- ❖ Most ballet classes are required to have a bun.
- ❖ We recommend using a hairnet for buns (for some classes it is required).
- ❖ For bun help, see the make-up/Hair tips on page 11.

BALLET

tutu ballet (TH): pink ballet shoes, pink tights, ballet bun at crown of head, hair piece clipped to front center of bun

tutu ballet (FRI): pink ballet shoes, pink tights, ballet bun at crown of head, tiara headband bobby pinned in place so that it stays while dancing.

tutu ballet 2 (TUES): pink ballet shoes, pink tights, ballet bun (at crown of head), hair clip opposite the flower on costume

ballet one (TUES): pink ballet shoes, pink tights, ballet bun (at crown of head), hair clip opposite the flower on costume

Arthur: black ballet shoes, black pants, white shirt, pink vest, hair neat

ballet one (FRI): pink ballet shoes, pink tights, ballet bun at crown of head, hair piece clipped to dancer's right (opposite the flower on costume).

ballet one INT (MON): pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in bun at crown of head, hair piece centered in front of bun

ballet one INT (TUES): pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in bun at crown of head with hair net, hair piece on left side of bun

ballet one ADV: pink ballet shoes, pink tights, hair in bun at crown of head, hair piece center at front of bun

ballet 2: pink ballet shoes, pink tights, bun at crown of head, hair piece on left of bun

Jabari: black socks and black ballet shoes

ballet 2 INT: pink ballet shoes, pink tights, hair in bun at crown of head (w/ hair net), hair piece on left side of bun

ballet 2 ADV: pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in bun at crown of head (w/ hair net), hair piece on left side of bun

ballet III: pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in low bun with hair net, no hair piece

ballet III ADV: pink tights and pink ballet shoes, bun at crown of head (with hair net), hair piece on left of bun

ballet four ADV: pink tights, pink ballet shoes, hair in bun at crown of head (with hair net), no hair piece

ePIC ballet: white leotard, white skirt, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, ballet bun at crown of head (with hair net)

Abby - white leotard, white tutu, pink tights, pink pointe shoes, same hair as above

Molly - Black leotard, black tutu, pink tights, pink pointe shoes, same hair as above

Pointe one: pink pointe shoes, pink tights, hair in bun at crown of head (hair net), no hair piece

Pointe 2: pink pointe shoes, pink tights, hair in bun at crown of head (hair net), no hair piece

Pointe III: pointe shoes, no tights, hair in bun at crown of head with hair net

tEEN ballet: pink ballet shoes, pink tights, bun at crown of head, hair piece centered at front of bun

Revival: striped leotard, black tights, skin tone ballet shoes, hair in bun at the crown of the head

JAZZ

Tutu jazz: black jazz shoes, skin tone tights, hair accessory pinned to front center of ponytail

jazz one (TH): black jazz shoes, tan tights, hair in ponytail at crown of head, hair bow centered at ponytail

jazz one (FRI): black jazz shoes, skin tone tights, hair in 2 high pigtails with scrunchies wrapped around each ponytail

jazz one INT: black jazz shoes, skin tone tights, high ponytail, scarf tied around neck

jazz one ADV: black jazz shoes, skin tone tights, high ponytail with rhinestone cuff around base.

jazz 2: black jazz shoes, skin tone tights, high ponytail with rhinestone cuff around base.

jazz 2 INT: black jazz shoes, skin tone tights, hair in ponytail at crown of head, hair piece around ponytail

jazz 2 ADV: barefoot, hair in braided ponytail (low), bandana tied around head (see costume picture in your portal)

jazz III ADV: barefoot, Hair in braided ponytail at crown of head

jazz four: barefoot, middle-part, low ponytail

ePIC jazz: barefoot, headpiece on right side of the head, no shoes, no tights, hair in braided ponytail at crown of head
tEEN jazz: black jazz shoes, fedora hat tilted toward dancer's right and tipped slightly forward, will decide on gloves as a class. If dancer's hair allows, slicked back low ponytail.

MODERN

modern one: barefoot, hair in braided ponytail (low), no hairpiece
modern 2: barefoot, hair in braided ponytail at crown of head, no hairpiece
modern III: barefoot, hair in braided ponytail at crown of head, no hairpiece
modern four: barefoot, hair in braided ponytail at crown of head, no hair piece
ePIC modern: barefoot, hair in braided ponytail at crown of head, no hairpiece

CONTEMPORARY

Contemporary one: barefoot, hair in bun at crown of head, hairpiece underneath bun at back of head
Contemporary 2: barefoot, hair in low bun, no hairpiece
Contemporary III: barefoot, hair in bun at crown of head, no hair piece
Contemporary four: barefoot, hair in bun at crown of head, no hairpiece
ePIC Contemporary: barefoot, hair in bun on crown of head, no hairpiece

MUSICAL THEATER

musical theater one: black jazz shoes, skin tone tights (if necessary), and a leotard or shorts under skirts
TONY: lion costume and black jazz shoes

TAP

Perkinson Center RULE: Tap shoes will not be allowed in the multi-Purpose Room (dressing room). Their floors have been heavily marked up from multiple studios performing there (wearing tap shoes), and they are trying to avoid having to replace the floor. If your child is in the multi-purpose room and in a tap dance, they will put their shoes on in the hallway leading to the backstage area. We will have plenty of volunteers to assist in this process. Please remember that the Perkinson Center is a non-profit and rely on people like us to rent the facility in order to keep it going. Let's help them preserve their floors by abiding by their rules.

tap one A: black tap shoes, skin tone tights, ponytail at crown of head with accessory clipped to dancer's left side of ponytail.

tap one B (girls): black tap shoes, tan tights, hair in ponytail at crown of head with bow center

Jabari: black tap shoes, black pants, pink shirt

tap one ADV: black tap shoes, skin tone tights, hair in ponytail at crown of head w/ clip on top center, wear wristlets on wrists.

- **Tony, Holden:** black tap shoes, black socks (if needed), tuxedo jacket, wear white button-up shirt & black pants from last recital

Tap 2: black tap shoes, hair in ponytail at crown of the head with ponytail clip around it

tap 2 ADV: skin tone tights, black tap shoes, own white tank top, hair in ponytail at crown of head

Shane: black tap shoes, no show socks (if want/need), own white shirt and jeans

tap III A: black tap shoes, no-show socks if needed, ponytail at crown of head with hair clip on top right side, pants should be hemmed to top of tap shoe (email sent)

tap III B: black tap shoes, skin tone tights, ponytail at crown of head, no scarf.

tap III ADV: black tap shoes (no show socks if you need them), hem pants to the middle of the ankle bone, jacket is buttoned, sleeve of jacket is right below wrist bone, hair in a ponytail at the crown of your head (no hair accessory)

tap four A/B: black tap shoes, see Miss Lauren

ePIC Tap: black tap shoes, see Miss Lauren

HIP-HOP

tutu hip hop: adidas superstars or any black similar tennis shoe if could not find size, no-show socks, hair in ponytail at crown of head, hair bow centered at ponytail.

hip hop one (TH): adidas superstars, no-show socks, OWN black t-shirt, low ponytail

BOYS: adidas superstars, no-show socks, own black t-shirt, hair neat

hip hop one ADV: adidas superstars, no-show socks, low ponytail

BOYS: adidas superstars, no show socks, hair neat

hip hop 2: adidas superstars, no-show socks, high ponytail with scrunchie around base.

hip hop 2 ADV: khaki pants, white shirt, tie, adidas superstars, no-show socks, low ponytail

Cooper: Khaki pants, white shirt, tie, undershirt (white), adidas superstars, no show socks, hair neat

hip hop III: adidas superstars, no-show socks, low ponytail

ePIC hip hop: all white tennis shoes (dELIRIUM wear production shoes), no-show socks, low ponytail

All students are required to wear make up for the performances. Dancers, even the young ones, wear makeup on stage in order to make their faces and expressions visible to the audience. Makeup can emphasize facial features that would otherwise be washed out by bright stage lights. TICKET SALES

Recital tickets will be sold online, through the Perkinson Center, by using the link below (**link will be LIVE on May 1st**). To purchase tickets simply click the link below and follow the instructions (Directions for Purchasing Tickets):

- **LINKS for pre-paid tickets with promo codes will be sent out at the end of April.**
- PRE-PAID tickets 1-2 classes = 2 tickets to ONE show, 3-4 classes = 4 tickets total to 1-2 shows, 5+ classes = 6 tickets total to the shows of your choosing
- **For the first two weeks of the link being live, you will only be able to purchase your pre-paid tickets. Once that 2-week period is up (May 15th), you will be able to purchase more tickets (IF they are available). We want to ensure that everyone gets their allotted tickets before opening up sales.**
- **REMINDER:** You **MUST** “purchase” your pre-paid tickets through the venue’s system. They are not automatically given to you, nor or are they reserved. If you wait too long (past the 2 weeks), you may miss out on seeing your child dance.
- There is an online service fee of \$1.50-2.00 for tickets that is beyond our control.

- Sales generated from the recital tickets go towards the costs of the shows (i.e., rental of venue, lighting, programs, necessary materials, props, staff, etc.).

DIRECTIONS FOR PURCHASING TICKETS

1. Use the link provided by CDC for your package (will be sent via email at the end of April)

3. Choose the shows that you would like to use your tickets on. You can split your shows up between as many shows as you'd like, or use them all on the same show.

4. ALL seats will be **GENERAL ADMISSION**.
5. Click "Proceed to next step"
6. On the confirmation page, review your seat selection and say "Add to Cart"
7. This will give you your cart.
 - a. If you are finished, choose how you want to get your tickets, optionally add names to the tickets, and click "Continue".
 - b. If you still need tickets to other shows, click "Continue Shopping" on the top right and on the next screen, navigate down to the CDC shows. Then choose whatever other seats you need.
8. When finished, pay for your cart!

AUDIENCE ETIQUETTE

Cell Phones

Upon entering the theater, please turn off all cell phones to a silent setting. If you need to make or receive a call please do so outside of the theater (refer to "Coming and Going" below).

Coming and Going

Please do not leave the auditorium during a dance performance unless, of course, there is an emergency. During the breaks in a recital, before and after a dance number is performed, the usher will allow you to move in and out of the auditorium. There will also be an intermission, which will be noted in your program, during which everyone is permitted to enter and exit the auditorium.

Noises and Children

Please do your best to refrain from any excess noise making while in the theater. If you have small children who start to fuss, please find the nearest exit. Remember to respect those around you and the performers on stage.

Photos and Videos

Flash photography of any kind is strictly prohibited during the performance as it is a hazard to the dancers. There will be a professional videographer for all the performance. Chesterfield Dance Center, LLC owns the rights to all choreography performed onstage and unauthorized videos will be confiscated.

Food and Drink

Food and drinks are ALLOWED in the theater. During intermission, the theater will have snacks and drinks available for purchase at their concession stand. Please be sure to dispose of all trash; don't leave it on the floor for someone else to clean up.

Clothing

Often times, the theater is kept cold, so bring a sweater or dress in layers to be more comfortable.

Dancers

All dancers should watch the show from the LIVE Stream in the dressing rooms.

VIDEOS

Shutter Storm will be recording during all shows. Every dancer (or family) will receive a digital download of ALL shows that was paid with part of your recital fee.

Please allow 6-10 weeks for processing and editing.

Your digital download will come from a Dance Studio-Pro email, and will also be found on your parent portal as soon as the download is available (under email history).

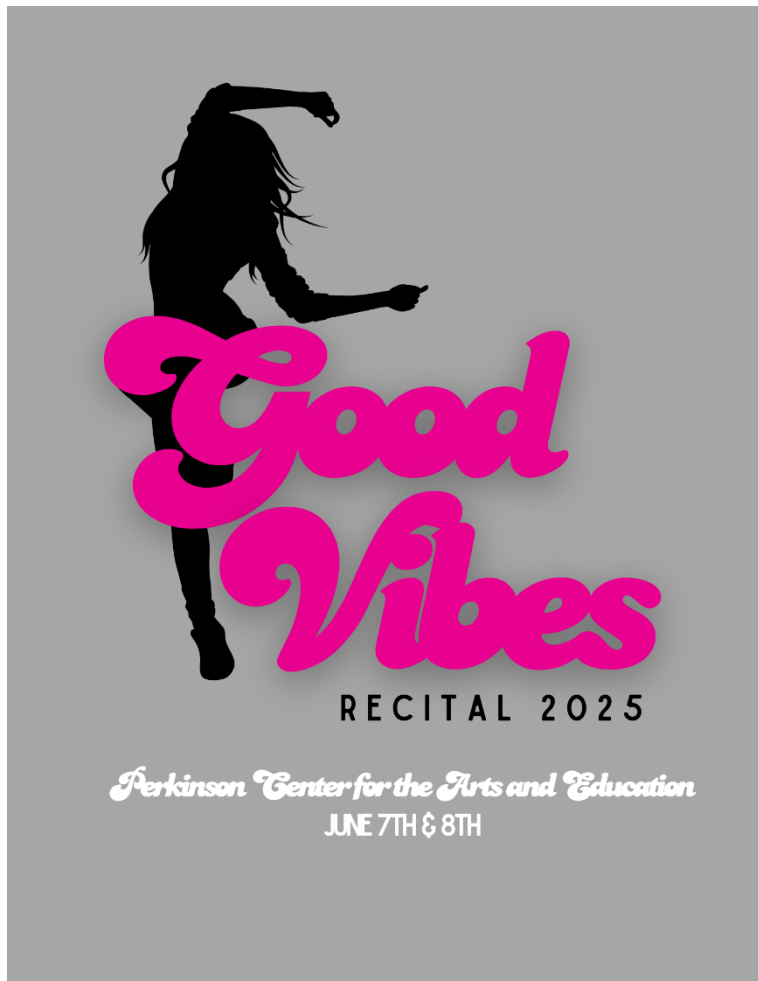
